Recipes for Camping

Carrot Relish by Linda Mosbrook

Peel and thinly slice 1 pound of carrots. Cook in small amount of lightly salted water until barely tender – a very few minutes. (I use a pressure cooker, maybe 2 minutes.) Do not overcook, but it isn't a disaster if you do. Drain carrots in colander and cool.

1/2 green bell pepper, diced 1/2 red bell pepper, diced The green from 3 or 4 green enjoys, slice

The green from 3 or 4 green onions, sliced A few inner, tender celery leaves, cut thin


 $\frac{1}{2}$ can low salt tomato soup (10 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz size)

1/4 cup Girard's "Original" flavor salad dressing, (or Italian of your choice)

1 tsp regular mustard
½ tsp Worcestershire sauce
1 tsp Seasoned salt, or to taste

¼ cup brown sugar

Mix ingredients well and pour over carrots in tight fitting container. Tip container a couple of times to distribute sauce thoroughly. Refrigerate at least overnight, but 2 or 3 days is also fine. Tip container a couple of times while refrigerated. I drain off much of the sauce in a colander before serving, and serve cold. Enjoy.






