

Early Arrivals:

The "official" start of the Rally is Friday, October 23rd at 11:30 AM. We are kicking it off with lunch available in the Lodge Club Room; but, there are activities planned as early as Thursday for those of you arriving early! Our Lodge meeting is held on Thursday evening at 8PM, and the Club Room will be open to spouses for dinner prior to the start of the meeting.
