Secretary's report by Jim Young:

October minutes were announced as printed in the November newsletter Larry Hoffman sent out. No additions or corrections to the minutes were brought up. The minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's report by Eileen Rasmussen:

Monthly report was read and approved as read. Our Elk-Enders at the CAHI rally in Hemet turned in the 3rd highest amount (almost \$1,600.00) to the Major Projects out of 27 lodges represented. 
